

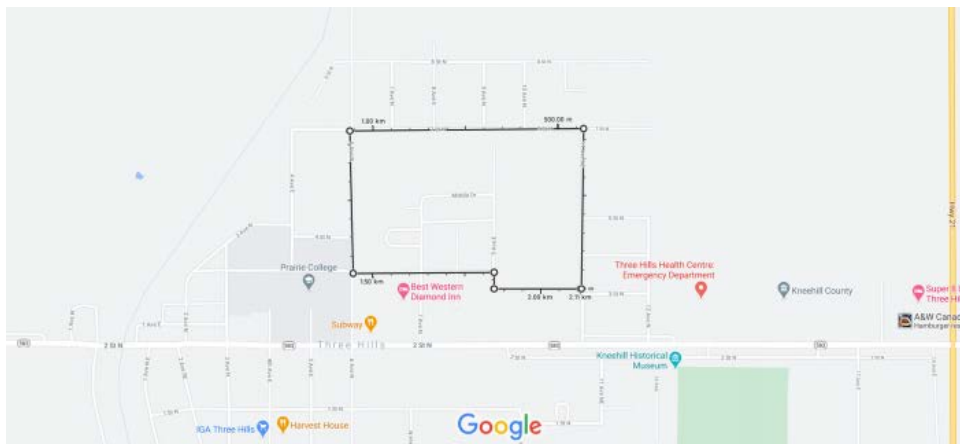


Dear PCA community,
