

Prairie Christian Academy (PCA) welcomes international students and ESL programming is provided to students through one on one support for language acquisition and homework support. Extra tutoring is available to all students by classroom teachers and after class. Dormitory students have access to the peer tutor network in the residence in the evenings. Private tutoring can also be arranged for a fee. The school counselor, admissions clerk and residence staff work together to aid with post secondary choices and applications. The Principal coordinates timetables with all students. International students attending PCA are integrated into the school and supported through small class sizes, sports teams and dormitory trips to the city for shopping, sushi, and entertainment. Dormitory trips to Banff, Calgary and Edmonton are arranged to allow students to experience the culture and beautiful creation in Alberta.
