KACY NELSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (DORMITORY)

Minimum Requirements

- Application deadline for consideration of the coming school year is **May 31**.
- The applicant must be female.
- The applicant must be a new dormitory student.
- Applicants can receive one scholarship in the same school year (bursaries excluded).

Additional Considerations

- The applicant's financial need must be equal to or greater than \$1500.00
- Greater consideration will be given to applicants who demonstrate greater financial need.
- Greater consideration will be given to students entering grade 10.

Dispersal

- The maximum amount dispersed per scholarship is \$1500.
- There are a maximum of three scholarships available each year.
- If possible, the Finance Committee will seek to disperse the scholarship to one applicant from Alberta, to one North American applicant outside the province of Alberta, and to one student from outside North America.

NEW MALE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP (DORMITORY)

Minimum Requirements

- Application deadline for consideration of the coming school year is **May 31**.
- The applicant must be male.
- The applicant must be a new dormitory student.
- Applicants can receive one scholarship in the same school year (bursaries excluded).

Additional Considerations

- The applicant's financial need must be equal to or greater than \$1500.00
- Greater consideration will be given to applicants who demonstrate greater financial need.
- Greater consideration will be given to students entering grade 10.
- If possible, the Financial Committee will seek to distribute the scholarship to one applicant from Alberta, to one North American applicant outside the province of Alberta, and to one student from outside North America.

Dispersal

- The maximum amount dispersed per scholarship is \$1500.
- There are a maximum of three scholarships available each year.

- Applicants can receive one scholarship in the same school year (bursaries excluded).

Additional Considerations

- The applicant's financial need must be equal to or greater than \$1500.00
- Greater consideration will be given to applicants who demonstrate greater financial need.
- Greater consideration will be given to students entering grade 10.
- If possible, the Financial Committee will seek to distribute the scholarship to one applicant from Alberta, to one North American applicant outside the province of Alberta, and to one student outside North America.

Dispersal

- The maximum amount dispersed per scholarship is \$1500.
- There are a maximum of three scholarships available each year.

RETURNING STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP (DORMITORY)

Minimum Requirements

- Application deadline for consideration of the coming school year is May 31.

- Applicants can receive one scholarship in the same school year (bursaries excluded).
- The applicant's Society Fees must be current.

Additional Considerations

- The applicant's financial need must be equal to or greater than \$1500.00
- Greater consideration will be given to applicants who demonstrate greater financial need.
- Greater consideration will be given to students entering grade 11.
- Greater consideration will be given to students who have not received bursaries or scholarships in the past.

Dispersal

- The maximum amount dispersed per scholarship is \$1500.
- There are a maximum of three scholarships available each year.
- If possible, the Financial Committee will seek to distribute the scholarship to one applicant from Alberta, to one North American applicant outside the province of Alberta, and to one student outside North America.
